**National Sports University, Manipur**

**2007. DR. THOKCHOM MEINYA:**

**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the construction of the National Sports University in Manipur has begun;**
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof;**
- (c) the estimated cost for the construction and the amount spent on it so far; and**
- (d) the time by which the University is likely to start functioning?**

**ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Madam. Government has started work for establishing National Sports University (NSU) at Koutruk, West Imphal District of Manipur.**

- (b) Hindustan Steelworks Construction Limited (HSCL), the Project Management Consultant engaged for setting up of NSU, has started survey, soil testing and peripheral boundary work at the site, preparatory to full-fledged construction.**
- (c) The total cost of the project, including Outlying Campuses of the University, would be tentatively Rs. 500 crore. Phase-1 of the Project has been estimated to be Rs. 91 crore. Rs. 13.50 crore has already been released to HSCL.**
- (d) The University will be fully functional by 2021-22. However, pending completion of construction work at Koutruk, it has been decided to start degree courses in a few disciplines of NSU from its temporary premises at Khuman Lampak Sports Complex, Imphal, from the coming academic session after the National Sports University Bill, 2017, becomes Law.**
