TARGETS UNDER PMAY-G

**2033. SHRIMATI POONAMBEN MAADAM:
SHRI ASHOK MAHADEORAO NETE:**

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any target has been fixed for providing houses to all rural poor by the year 2022;
- (b) if so, the details of the number of people, out of the total population of the country, who have been identified for coverage under this scheme, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of housing units proposed to be constructed by the year 2019 and the total number of housing units constructed during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the Government is contemplating to increase the target for the current year; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)**

(a) & (b): To achieve the objective of 'Housing for All by 2022' the rural housing scheme Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) has been re-structured into Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) which aims to provide pucca house with basic amenities to all houseless households and households living in houses with kutchra wall and kutchra roof having zero, one or two rooms as per Socio Economic and Caste Census (SECC), 2011 data, after applying the 13 point exclusion criteria, and verification by Gram Sabha.

As on 21st July, 2017 2.51 crore households have been found eligible to receive assistance under PMAY-G after due verification by the Gram Sabha and review by Appellate Committee.

(c) : Under PMAY-G, one crore houses are proposed to be constructed over a period of three years from 2016-17 to 2018-19. A statement indicating houses constructed under PMAY-G (erstwhile IAY) during last three years and current years is given at Annexure-I.

(d) & (e) : Presently, no such proposal to increase the targets in the current financial year is under consideration in the Ministry of Rural Development.
