- a) whether Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT) between India and the USA have been put on hold and if so, the details thereof;
- b) whether the shelving of the BIT has adversely impacted American investment in India, if so, the details thereof; and
- c) whether the issue was sought to be addressed during the Indian PM's visit to the US recently and if so, the details thereof and the outcome thereon?
