2127. SHRI ABHISHEK SINGH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritava Abhiyan (PMSMA) drive launched for providing better health facilities for pregnant women in the country including Chhattisgarh State;
- (b) the fund allocated for the above scheme during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the number of private doctors who have been associated with the said drive in the country including Chhattisgarh?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

- (a): Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan in being implemented in all States/ UTs in more than 11900 facilities. More than 65 lakh antenatal checkups have been conducted under the programme across States/ UTs, of which more than 3 lakh checkups have been conducted in Chhattisgarh.
- (b): PMSMA has been initiated in 2016-17 for comprehensive and quality antenatal care services. Funds for conducting antenatal checkups of pregnant women are approved as part of the ongoing JSSK programme. States/ UTs have been asked to utilize these funds for ANC checkups under PMSMA programme.
- (c): More than 4200 private sector doctors have registered to provide voluntary services under PMSMA, of which 239 doctors have registered in Chhattisgarh.
