**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state :**

- (a) whether the Government has made it mandatory for vacancies in Government Departments to be posted on the National Career Services (NCS) Portal;**
- (b) the details of candidates and establishments registered on the NCS portal and job fairs organised by NCS in 2016-17;**
- (c) the details of memoranda of understanding inked by NCS with leading job portals, placement organisations and institutions of repute; and**
- (d) the details of Model Career Centres set up/ being set up across the country to deliver quality employment services, State/UT-wise?**

- (a) The Department of Personnel and Training vide O.M No.39020/09/2011-Estt(B) dated 02.11.2016 has decided that in addition to existing procedure for advertisement of Government vacancies it shall now be mandatory to be placed on National Career Service Portal.**
- (b) Till March 2017, there were 3.9 crore Job- Seekers and 14.87 lakh establishments on the NCS Portal. Around 540 Job fairs have been organised under NCS during 2016-17 through the career centres.**
- (c) The list of organisations/ institutions having Memorandum of Understanding with NCS is at Annex-A.**
- (d) The NCS Project includes establishment of 100 Model Career Centres in Employment Exchanges and institution of repute to provide variety of employment related services. The state/ UT wise details of Model Career Centres is at Annex- B.**
