Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to open a new Kendriya Vidyalaya in Kottarakara of Kerala; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the progress made so far in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

- (a): Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence personnel on receipt of a proposal in the prescribed proforma from a Ministry / Department of Govt. of India / State Governments / Union Territory Administration thereby committing the availability of requisite resources for setting up a new KV as well as on the availability of necessary sanction of the Government.
- (b): There is no sanction of the Government for opening of a new KV at Kottarakara, Distt. Kollam (Kerala). Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that it has received a proposal from the State Government of Kerala for opening of a new KV at Kottarakara, which has been found to be fulfilling the prerequisites for opening of a new KV under the civil sector.
