Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Government is aware of the agitation going on in Puthuvype, Kerala against setting up of LPG terminal there and if so, the details thereof; and

(b) whether the setting up of LPG terminal is in violation of the Green Tribunal norms and if so, the details thereof along with measures being taken by the Government against such violation?

(a) Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) has reported that due to agitation by local people, the work of the LPG Terminal has been affected and the work has been currently suspended as per advice of the State Government.

(b) IOCL has reported that Environmental Clearance for the LPG Import Terminal was obtained on 5th July 2010, and that National Green Tribunal (NGT) in its order dated 2nd August, 2016 permitted IOCL to resume the work on this terminal.
