**POSTS IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS**

**2372. SHRI K. PARASURAMAN:**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that many teaching and non-teaching posts have been filled in the Kendriya Vidyalaya schools on temporary and contractual basis;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the total number of contractual and temporary teachers working in the KV schools across the country, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has initiated action to fill up vacancies of teachers on permanent basis; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)**

(a): Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that vacancies of regular teachers are filled by contractual teachers as per requirement. However, non-teaching posts are not filled by contractual staff.

(b): The State / UT-wise details of the total number of contractual and temporary teachers working in the Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) across the country are annexed.

(c) & (d): Filling up of vacancies of teaching staff is a continuous process in KVS. KVS has informed that written examination has been conducted and interviews have been held for filling up of 6205 teaching posts through Direct Recruitment. Offers of appointment have also been issued by KVS for 84 posts of Principals. In addition, action has also been initiated for filling up of 4473 teaching posts through Limited Departmental Examination.
