- (b) whether there has been any delay in auction of coal blocks resulting in wastage of Coal Bed Methane and if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a): In order to exploit Coal Bed Methane (CBM) potential in the country, the Government formulated CBM policy in 1997. Under CBM policy, 33 exploration blocks were awarded, out of these, currently 14 blocks are operational, 15 blocks are under relinquishment and 4 blocks have been relinquished. Out of 14 operational blocks 5 blocks are under production/incidental production. The details of CBM production during last three years and current year is as under:
