TOURISM POTENTIAL OF ALLAHABAD

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any study to access the tourism potential of Allahabad;
- (b) if so, the details regarding potential of tourism and plans for development of tourism in Allahabad; and
- (c) the number of tourism projects under consideration of the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) to (c): Conducting study to assess the tourism potential for development of tourism of a tourist spot is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments and Union Territories including the State Government of Uttar Pradesh.

Based on these assessments, the State Governments and Union Territories prepares Detailed Project Report (DPR) and submits it to the Ministry of Tourism for Central Financial Assistance as per the existing Scheme Guidelines.

The State Government of Uttar Pradesh has received Central Financial Assistance for development of Allahabad to the tune of Rs.23.00 crore which pertains to Shringverpur in Allahabad district in Ramayana Circuit under Swadesh Darshan Scheme out of a total of Rs.69.45 crore extended to them.
