**Changes in School Curriculum**

2519. SHRI RAYAPATI SAMBASIVA RAO:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of major initiatives taken/proposed by the Government to bring about changes in the curriculum in the secondary education during the last three years;
- (b) whether any Committee has been set up during the said period to go into curriculum to bring about changes;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the last instance when the changes were brought about by the in curriculum in secondary education in the country?

- (a) The curriculum is reviewed every year on the basis of suggestions received in this regard. The review broadly pertains to rectification of factual errors, if any, and updation of data.
- (b) to (d) The review is done internally by the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT). No specific committee has been set up for this purpose.
- (e) The National Curriculum Framework (NCF) 2005 is the latest National Curriculum Framework. The last review was done in the year 2016.

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
