Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of proposals received by the Government under old age homes and drug deaddiction centres during 2016-17 and the status of the said proposals, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh;

(b) the details of assistance provided by the Government to the said centres, State/UT-wise;

(c) whether a number of proposals are pending for approval of the Government and if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and

(d) the time by which the pending proposals are likely to be approved?

ANSWER

(a) to (b): A total of 325 proposals for old age homes and 501 proposals for drug de-addiction centres were received online in the Ministry during 2016-17. The status of the said proposals and details of assistance provided to the said centres, State/UT-wise is at Annexure-I.

(c) to (d): Proposals, for release of grant-in-aid are processed as per the norms and guidelines of the relevant Schemes, subject to their completeness in all respects and availability of funds etc. The release of funds is a continuous ongoing process. Therefore, no conclusive timeline can be indicated for release of grant in aid.
