- (a) whether the Government has taken steps to increase the financial assistance/grants for SC/OBC students to the States and NGOs working for their welfare and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether it is a fact that the rates/ norms for some of the schemes have been revised lately;
- (c) whether there is scope for further revision; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken/proposed to be taken in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI KRISHAN PAL GURJAR)

- (a) and (b): Government has taken various steps like increasing the income ceiling in the eligibility criteria and revision of the rates to increase the financial assistance/grants for SC/OBC students to the States under relevant Centrally Sponsored Schemes and NGOs working for their welfare. The details are annexed.
- (c) and (d): The Schemes are reviewed from time to time and rates of financial assistance/grants including the eligibility criteria are changed on the basis of needs, subject to the availability of budget.
