- (a) the number of individual and group enterprises that have been set up under the self employment programme component of DAY-NULM;
- (b) whether CCTVs have been installed in shelters for women and children to ensure their security; and
- (c) the steps taken to improve the livelihood opportunities of the urban poor?

(a) The details of number of persons assisted with subsidised loans for individual and group microenterprises under SEP component under DAY-NULM during the last three years are at Annexure.

- (b) Implementation of Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) component of DAY-NULM rests with respective States/UT Governments. As per Operational Guidelines of SUH, to address security issues and monitoring of shelters for vulnerable groups, CCTV camera may be installed at entry and exit points of shelters.
- (c) Under DAY-NULM, skill training is imparted to urban poor in market oriented courses to improve their employability and to enable them to start self-employment ventures. Interest Subvention is provided on individual and group bank loans sanctioned to enable them to set up microenterprises. Self Help Groups are also linked with banks to encourage them to undertake income-generating activities.
