(b): During the year 2016-17, in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, 119 UMLCs and 34 UMLCs have been eliminated respectively. Target for elimination of UMLCs for 2017-18 in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana is 71 and 16 respectively. During the current year i.e. 2017-18 (upto June 2017), in Andhra Pradesh 15 UMLCs have been eliminated and in Telangana 3 UMLCs have been eliminated.
