2781. SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA: KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Karnataka has poor railway connectivity with 16 Km. per 1000 sq km. against the National average of 27 Km. and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether Karnataka has the least number of electrified and/or doubled B.G. lines compared to other States in India and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the present targeted date of completion of Chikmagalur-Sakleshpura, Hassan-Bangalore, Munirabad-Raichur, Bagalkot-Kudachi, Tumkur-Davangere and Rayadurga-Tumkur railway lines?

STATEMENT REFERED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.2781 BY SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA AND KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 02.08.2017 REGARDING POOR RAILWAY CONNECTIVITY

- (a): As per records available, as on 31.03.2016 extent of railway network available in Karnataka is 17.11km per 1000sq km compared to the national average of 20.27 km.
- (b): As on 01.04.2017, the State of Karnataka has 632 route Km of electrified Broad Gauge (BG) railway line which is higher than that of many other States.

State-wise data on doubled BG lines is not maintained. However total Running Track Km (which include single, double and more than doubled lines) of Karnataka is 4076.16 km as on 31.03.2016 which is more than Kerala (1680.05), Haryana (2375.63), Assam (2554.58), Odisha(3876.77), Punjab (2729.21) and Telengana (2440.87). Further, 13 doubling projects falling fully/partly in the State of Karnataka are in progress. Total length of these projects is 1882.5 Km.

(c): Completion of projects depends on a number of factors such as acquisition of land, forestry and wildlife clearances, shifting of various services, construction of Road Over Bridges/Road under Bridges by road maintenance departments, apart from availability of adequate funds. Since many of these factors are beyond the control of the Ministry of Railways, it is not feasible to indicate time-frames for completion of all the projects. However, project-wise status of sections is as under:-
