Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has recently issued directives to the State Governments/UTs against diverting urban development funds meant for improving urban infrastructure and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the funds released to various States/UTs for development of urban infrastructure, scheme and programme-wise during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the reports received by the Union Government about misuse of funds by State Governments/UTs during the above period; and
- (d) the action contemplated by the Union Government on such misuse of funds by the State Governments/UTs?
