(a) & (b): In Railway Budget 2016-17, introduction of Antyodaya, Humsafar, UDAY, Tejas brand of train services have been announced. The details of the trains which are yet to be introduced out of the announced 7 Antyodaya Express, 10 Humsafar Express, 3 UDAY Express & 3 Tejas Express along with route are as under:

Antyodaya Express

- (i) 15567/15568 Darbhanga-Jalandhar City Antyodaya Express (Weekly) via Gorakhpur, Moradabad, Chandigarh, Ludhiana**
- (ii) 22841/22842 Santragachi-Chennai Central Antyodaya Express (Weekly) via Bhubaneswar, Visakhapatnam, Vijaywada**
- (iii) 22895/22896 Bilaspur-Firozpur Antyodaya Express (Weekly) via Anuppur, Jhansi, Delhi Safdarjung, Rohtak, Bathinda**
- (iv) 22921/22922 Bandra(T)-Gorakhpur Antyodaya Express (Weekly) via Surat, Vadodara, Kota, Kanpur Central, Lucknow, Gonda**
- (v) 15563/15564 Jaynagar-Udhna Antyodaya Express (Weekly) via Darbhanga, Mughalsarai, Jabalpur, Itarsi, Bhusaval, Jalgaon**

Humsafar Express

- (i) 22317/22318 Sealdah-Jammu Tawi Humsafar Express (Weekly) via Gaya, Mughalsarai, Varanasi, Lucknow, Moradabad, Ambala Cantt., Ludhiana**

- (ii) **22913/22914 Bandra(T)-Patna Humsafar Express (Weekly) via Valsad, Udhna, Bhusaval, Itarsi, Jabalpur, Katni, Satna, Chheoki, Mughalsarai**

UDAY Express

- (i) **22665/22666 Coimbatore-Bengaluru UDAY Express (6 days a week) via Tiruppur, Erode, Salem**
- (ii) **22923/22924 Bandra(T)-Jamnagar UDAY Express (Tri-weekly) via Surat, Bharuch, Vadodara, Ahmedabad, Rajkot, Hapa**
- (iii) **22701/22702 Visakhapatnam-Vijaywada UDAY Express (5 days a week) via Duvvada, Ankapalli, Rajahmundry, Eluru**

Tejas Express

- (i) **22425/22426 New Delhi-Chandigarh Tejas Express (6 days a week)**
- (ii) **12585/12586 Lucknow Jn-Anand Vihar Tejas Express (6 days a week)**

Out of these, 1 Humsafar Express train, 1 Antyodaya Express train and 1 UDAY Express train will pass through Vapi station.
