MINI FOOD PARKS

287. SHRI DUSHYANT CHAUTALA:

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has implemented any scheme to provide incentives for setting up of mini food parks and to boost manufacturing activities and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has also received proposals from private entrepreneurs seeking subsidy and incentives for setting up of mini food parks; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the total funds sanctioned by the Government till now, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has no scheme to provide incentives for setting up of Mini Food Parks in the country. However, Government of India has approved a new Scheme for Creation of Infrastructure for Agro Processing Clusters under Central Sector Scheme - KISAN SAMPADA YOJANA for the period upto 2019-20. The objective of the scheme is to create modern infrastructure for food processing closer to production areas. The scheme envisages grants-in-aid of 35% of eligible project cost in general areas, 50% grants-in-aid of eligible project cost in the North East States including Sikkim and difficult areas namely Himalayan States (i.e. Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Uttarakhand), State notified ITDP areas & Islands subject to maximum of Rs. 10.00 crore per project.
