Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has entered into any MoUs with other Ministries and Departments for identification of unutilized Government buildings which can be converted to Skill Development Centres;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, whether the Ministry proposes to form such MoUs regarding identification of infrastructure for setting up Skill Development Centres; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

(a) to (c) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has entered into MOUs with various Ministries including Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Water Resources, Ministry of Civil Aviation etc. One of the agenda under these MOUs is optimal utilization of unutilized Government buildings/infrastructure for skill development related trainings. Ministry has also signed an MOU with Ministry of Railway for setting up of skill development centres in unused railway infrastructure. The TPs affiliated with NSDC have been selected for working in 10 identified locations for rolling out batches of training under PMKVY.
