HOTELS RUN BY RAILWAYS

2923. SHRI M. RAJA MOHAN REDDY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of hotels under the administrative control of the Railways as on date, location-wise; and**
- (b) the hotels given to private parties on lease basis for running, location-wise along with the terms and conditions laid down therefor?**

ANSWER

(a) and (b): Presently, four (4) hotels are owned by Indian Railways. These are Rail Yatri Niwas at New Delhi & Howrah and BNR Hotels at Ranchi & Puri. These hotels were handed over to Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd. (IRCTC) on 'as is where is basis' in August 2004 for operation and management. IRCTC thereafter, has on concession basis handed over these hotels to private hotel companies for a period of 15 years from December, 2006, for re-development, operation and maintenance of these Rail Yatri Niwas & Railway Hotels on suitable terms and conditions decided by IRCTC.
