(a) to (c): Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail (MAHSR) project has been sanctioned for implementation with technical and financial assistance of Government of Japan. National High Speed Rail ...2/...

Corporation Limited (NHSRCL) has been incorporated as a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) to undertake the implementation of this project. As per joint feasibility report, this project is targeted for commissioning in 2022-2023.

Rail connectivity already exists between Bengaluru and Vijayawada via Dharmavaram and Gooty as well as via Katpadi-Pakala-Tenali.

A new line project from Vijayawada to Guntur via Amravati (106 km) has been included in the Budget 2017-18 subject to requisite approvals.
