SETTING UP OF POLYTECHNICS

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of polytechnics located in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether some of the State Governments including Tamil Nadu have requested for grant of assistance from the Union Government for setting up of polytechnics;
- (c) if so, the details along with the action taken by the Union Government thereon; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) Total Number of All India Council For Technical Education (AICTE) approved (Engineering and Technology) institutes in the country as on 28.07.2017 is enclosed as per **Annexure-I.**
- "Sub-Mission on Polytechnics under (b) to (d) Coordinated Action Dévelopment" was launched during the 11th Plan. Setting up of New Polytechnics with Central assistance is one of the Components under the Sub-mission. Under this scheme, Central Government provides one-time financial assistance upto Rs.12.30 crores per polytechnic to the State/UT Governments for setting up of new polytechnics in 300 unserved and under-served districts of the country. State-wise number of these 300 districts including the state of Tamil Nadu is given at Annexure-II. The polytechnics are at various stages of construction and in provisioning of land. 295 such districts have been provided financial assistance so far. Out of 295, 157 Polytechnics have become operational till date under the scheme. In Tamil Nadu 7 districts are covered under this scheme in which all 7 polytechnics have become operational. The number of polytechnics covered and the total funds given till 2017 are available at http://mhrd.gov.in/technical-education-26. A total of Rs. 2485.91 crores has been released by Government of India as on 31.03.2017 for implementing the Scheme out of which Rs. 86.10 crores has been released to the State of Tamil Nadu.
