#### **INCREASE IN SPEED OF TRAINS**

#### 2980. SHRI ARKA KESHARI DEO:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Niti Aayog has approved Rs. 18000 crore of rupees recently for undertaking various works to increase the speed of trains in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of the rail routes selected for upgradation so that high speed trains could run thereon;
- (c) whether the Government has set any time limit in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

# **ANSWER**

- (a): Yes, Madam. NITI Aayog has supported two projects at an estimated cost of □ 18,163 crore for raising of speed to 160/200 kilometre per hour on existing corridors of Delhi-Mumbai (including Vadodara-Ahmedabad) and Delhi-Howrah (including Kanpur-Lucknow) in June 2017.
- (b): The rail routes selected for speed upgradation are:

- New Delhi-Mumbai route 1483 route kms. (including Vadodara-Ahmedabad).
- New Delhi-Howrah route 1525 route kms. (including Kanpur-Lucknow).
- (c) & (d): Time frame for operation of trains on upgraded corridors can be indicated only after the project is approved.
