Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Government of Rajasthan has sent proposals regarding construction of railway overbridges at the busiest level crossings;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the present status of these proposals;
- (c) the time by which these proposals are likely to be approved;
- (d) whether the State Government of Rajasthan has also sent a proposal regarding construction of railway overbridge at level crossing C-142, situated on the eastern side of Sadulpur railway station;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the present status of this proposal; and
- (f) the time by which the work of this railway overbridge is likely to be completed?

(a)to (c): State Government of Rajasthan has not sent any proposal to Zonal Railway for construction of Road Over Bridges for inclusion in Works Programme-2017-18.

(d) to (f): Level crossing No.142 in Sadulpur Railway station falls on National Highway. General Arrangement Drawing (GAD) of the proposed ROB has already been approved by Railway. Therefore, the same is to be constructed by National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) at their own cost on single entity basis as per Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed on 10.11.2014 between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MORTH).
