**PENDING RAIN WATER HARVESTING PROJECTS**

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any projects from the Government of Rajasthan about rain water harvesting are pending with the Union Government for sanction and budget provisions and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Union Government intends to sanction the said projects as well as to make budget provisions for them and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?
