(a) & (b) As against the sanctioned posts of 1320 in DGCA, 983 posts are filled and 337 posts are vacant. The details of the manpower in DGCA is at Annexure A.

Recruitment is a continuous process and the vacancies are filled in consonance with Recruitment Rules as and when they arise. Further, for technical posts, in view of urgency, vacancies are also filled up from time to time on Consultancy or Contract basis.
