(a) whether Indian carriers are able to utilise a mere half of the seats operated by foreign carriers to and from India, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether Federation of Indian Airlines (FIA) has approached the Government regarding non-availability of slots in overseas locations despite having flying rights;

(c) if so, the details thereof and Government's response thereto; and

(d) the steps taken or proposed to be taken by Government to ensure that domestic carriers get adequate slots?

(a): No Madam. As per Summer Schedule, 2017, Indian carriers are operating 292662 seats per week while foreign carriers are operating 519657 seats per week to/from India.

(b) to (d): Yes Madam, in December, 2015, Federation of Indian Airlines (FIA) had drawn the attention of the Government towards the non-availability of feasible slots at Dubai International Airport(DXB). The matter was taken up with the Dubai Civil Aviation Authority in January, 2016.
