(a): Yes, Madam. Office of the Development Commissioner [Handicrafts] implements various schemes for promotion and development of handicrafts sector through out the country including the state of Madhya Pradesh under "**National Handicraft Development Programme [NHDP]**" and **Comprehensive Handicrafts Cluster Development Scheme (CHCDS)**. **The NHDP has following components.**

1. Dastkar Shashktikaran Yojana under Ambedkar Hastshilp Vikas Yojna (AHVY)
2. Design & Technology Upgradation (DTU)
3. Human Resource Development (HRD)
4. Direct Benefit to Artisans (DBT)
5. Infrastructure and Technology Support (ITS)
6. Research and Development (R&D)
7. Marketing Support & Services (MSS)

Comprehensive Handicrafts Cluster Development Scheme (CHCDS) is also known as Mega Cluster scheme which cover all the components of **NHDP**. **Major components of CHCDS** are as detailed below:-

1. Mega Cluster (MC)
2. Special projects under Integrated Development and Promotion of Handicraft (IDPH)
