DECLARATION OF NHS IN HARYANA

3156. SHRI DHARAMBIR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of roads in Haryana declared as National Highways (NHs) during the last three years;
- (b) the funds allocated during the said period for development of NHs in the State; and
- (c) the total length of National Highways in the State?

- (a) The Ministry has declared six stretches of State Roads of about 580 km length as new National Highways (NHs) in the State of Haryana during last three years.
- (b) The details of funds allocated for development of NHs for the State of Haryana during the last three years are as under:-

Year	Allocation (Rs. Crore)
2014-15	60.48
2015-16	90.00
2016-17	150.00

State - wise allocation of funds are not made for development of NHs entrusted with National Highways Authority of India (NHAI).

- (c) The total length of NHs in the State of Haryana is about 2,641 km.
