Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether all National Highways (NHs) passing through Bihar are in a dilapidated condition;
- (b) if so, the steps taken by the Union Government for repair of all dilapidated National Highways (NHs) passing through the State;
- (c) whether the Union Government has not made payment for the repair of national highways, carried out by the State Government of Bihar;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the reasons for non-payment of outstanding amount by the Union Government?
