That campaign has now been replaced by "Darwaza Band" campaign, which stresses upon the usage of toilets and shutting the door on diseases caused by open defecation. This awareness campaign is presently going on using following media vehicles:-
 - (i) Doordarshan and its regional channels
 - (ii) All India Radio
 - (iii) Private TVs and Radios
- (II) Outdoor component of this campaign is being launched countrywide.
- (III) Arsenic and Fluoride awareness campaigns of National Rural Drinking Water is running on Doordarshan.
