(a) & (c): Public Health being a State subject, selection of NGOs and release of funds to NGOs in Health Sector lies under the jurisdiction of respective State/UT Governments. The Ministry does not select or release funds to NGOs directly and information regarding financial assistance to NGOs is not maintained at Central level. As per the information received from Government of Rajasthan, there are 157 NGOs working in Health Sector in Rajasthan as per **Annexure-I** and details of financial assistance provided to the NGOs are at **Annexure-II**
