(a) whether the Government has taken cognizance that M/s Alpic Finance Limited has not paid its investors money which was collected between 1998-2000 through secured redeemable debentures and if so, the details thereof,

(b) whether this company went into liquidation in 2004 and the liquidation proceeds are lying with the Bank of India (Bol) for the past many years;

(c) if so, the reasons for not paying/returning back the money to the investors of M/s Alpic Finance Limited; and

(d) the time by which the investors will be paid back their hard earned money?
