- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Four LCA Initial Operational Clearance (IOC) Series Production Aircraft have so far been delivered to the Indian Air Force by HAL. The LCA is being further developed as LCA Mk 1A, with better capabilities and better avionics with many maintainability improvements.
- (c) Induction of the indigenously developed LCA would help arrest the drawdown of fighter squadron strength of IAF. The experience and expertise gained from the LCA programme is expected to provide a boost to our indigenous capability to develop a fighter aircraft.
