SETTING UP OF TRAUMA CARE CENTRES

3403. SHRI B.S. YEDIYURAPPA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals from various States including Karnataka for setting up of trauma care centers and upgradation/ modernisation of medical colleges and AYUSH dispensaries;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the number of proposals approved by the Government and the funds released for the purpose during the said period, proposal-wise;
- (d) whether a number of above proposals are pending for approval of the Government; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor and the time by which these are likely to be approved by the Government?

ANSWER

(a) to (e):

- I.** Under the scheme “Capacity Building for Developing Trauma Care Facilities on National Highways”, out of a number of proposals received from various States, 81 Trauma Care Facilities have been approved by the Government during the last three years and the current year. The details of the proposals including funds released state-wise is at **Annexure I**. Further, funds to the tune of Rs. 5.57 crores were released to the Government of Karnataka during 2015-16 for six Trauma Care Facilities out of 8 Facilities approved during 11th Five Year Plan, under committed liability.
- II.** Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), 39 Government Medical Colleges (GMC) including 2 GMCs in Karnataka (Vijayanagar Institute of Medical Sciences (VIMS), Bellary and Karnataka Institute of Medical Sciences, Hubli) have been taken up for upgradation under PMSSY (Phase-III) with an outlay of Rs.150 crores (Central Share Rs.120 crore and State Share Rs.30 crores) per institute. The details of Medical Colleges taken up for upgradation under PMSSY Phase-III alongwith funds released are given in **Annexure-II**. In addition, upgradation of 13 Government Medical Colleges under Phase-IV of PMSSY with an approved outlay of Rs.200 crores (Central Share Rs.120 crore and State Share Rs.80 crores) per institute was approved last year. Besides the above, IMS, BHU, Varanasi and Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical

Sciences & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram have also been approved for upgradation under PMSSY Phase V(A) at a cost of Rs.230 crore each and Rs.10 crore has been released for each institute. List of GMCs/Institutes is given at **Annexure-III**.

- III.** Under the Scheme “Upgradation of existing State Government/Central Government medical colleges to increase MBBS seats in the country”, 22 Medical Colleges have been approved, to increase 1715 UG seats. Funds to the tune of Rs. 311.52 crore have been released to the State Governments till date.
- IV.** Under the Scheme, “Strengthening and upgradation of State Government Medical colleges for starting new PG disciplines and increasing PG seats”, launched during the 11th Plan period, a total of 72 Government Medical colleges in 21 States/UTs are covered. Funds to the tune of Rs. 791.78 crore have been released under the scheme, till date.
- V.** Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), proposals for upgradation of AYUSH Dispensaries in different States/UTs including Karnataka approved during the last three years and current year and their status are given at **Annexure-IV**. Further, the status of grants-in-aid released to State/UTs including Karnataka for different activities of NAM including upgradation of AYUSH Dispensaries during last three years is given at **Annexure-V**.
