REDUCED PROCUREMENT OF FOODGRAINS

345. SHRI K.N. RAMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the FCI has reduced procurement of foodgrains in the recent past;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of procurement made by the FCI during the last two years, State and year-wise; and
- (d) whether private parties are allowed to procure foodgrains, if so, the details of such private parties along with the quantum and the rate at which they are procured, during each of the last two years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI C. R. CHAUDHARY)

(a) & (b): The procurement of paddy in terms of rice and wheat during last three years by Food Corporation of India(FCI) and State Government/Agencies for Central Pool is as under:

From the above table, it can be seen that procurement of paddy in terms of rice has increased during the last three years. Procurement of wheat has also increased except for RMS 2016-17 when it was lower in some State due to proactive buying by private parties. However during current year RMS 2017-18, the same has increased.

- (c): The Procurement of wheat and paddy in terms of rice for the last two years and current year, State-wise, is enclosed as Annexure I & II respectively.
- (d): Private players have been engaged by FCI for procurement of paddy under Minimum Support Price (MSP) operations w.e.f KMS 2015-16 to enhance the outreach of MSP to the farmers in Eastern States.

Private players were engaged by FCI in States of UP, Jharkhand and West Bengal for procurement of Paddy. Private players procure paddy from farmers at MSP and Bonus, if any, declared for that relevant marketing season.

The details of the private parties engaged and the quantum procured during last two years i.e. KMS 2015-16 and KMS 2016-17 is available at Annexure-III.
