3495. SHRI VINOD KUMAR SONKAR:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of all the participating agencies involved in developing the indigenous breeds of cattle under the Rashtriya Gokul Mission;
- (b) the details of the works/ programmes undertaken/being undertaken by the participating agencies nominated by the Government under the Mission, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is reviewing the work undertaken by the participating agencies and if so, the progress made in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government has received complaints from these agencies and if so, the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- (e) the number of organisations/ agencies participated in establishing Gokul Gram under the PPP mode?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): The details of the implementing/participating agencies and works/programmes being undertaken by the agencies is given at Annexure-I.

(c) : For effective implementation of the scheme following steps has been taken by the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries: a) formulated guidelines which has been placed on the web site of the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries; b) notified compendium of Minimum Standard Protocol (MSP) & Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and made available to the States; c) prepared National Action Plan and circulated same among the States for proper implementation. Progress made by the States has been reviewed during the video conferencing, State Review Meetings and Regional Review Meetings. Progress made by the States is given at Annexure-I.

(d) & (e) No complaints have been received so far from implementing/participating agencies under the scheme. Funds have been sanctioned under the scheme for establishment of 14 Gokul Grams in 9 States of the country. However, States are not undertaking establishment of Gokul Grams under PPP mode.
