ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR DISASTER MITIGATION

3509. SHRIMATI RITA TARAI:

(a) whether the Government proposes to issue such guidelines in which geographical vulnerabilities are considered in the process of allocation of resources to the States so that disaster mitigation is adequately addressed; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (b): Disaster Management (DM) is the primary responsibility of the State Governments in their respective jurisdiction. The Central Government supplements their efforts whenever required.

At present, the Government of India does not propose to issue specific guidelines in which geographical vulnerabilities are considered in the process of allocation of resources to the States to address disaster mitigation. However, while allocating resources for disaster management including mitigation due consideration is given to vulnerability of the States.
