Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which the Government encourages various agencies engaged in border security, internal security, anti-naxal activities and relief work by reviewing them.
- (b) whether the Government organises various social activities other than welfare programmes like free medical camps; and
- (c) the manner in which the Government encourages the agencies for organising social events from time to time?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (c): Civic Action Programmes (CAPs) are carried out in border and militancy/naxal infested area to act as a bridge between the security force and the local people.

Various social activities other than welfare programmes carried out under CAP are like development of village infrastructure, distribution of teaching aids, sports items etc., multi skills development training in tailoring/embroidery etc. including vocational training, pre-recruitment training for government jobs, sports activities, Bharat Darshan Tour, assisting Divyang Jan (Handicaps), counseling on sanitization and hygiene. Funds are allocated for civic action plans.
