## LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.3534 TO BE ANSWERED ON 08.08.2017

#### **Employment in Heavy Industries**

3534. SHRI DEEPENDER SINGH HOODA:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there has been an increase or decrease in the number of new employment generated by the Heavy Industries (large scale industries) and Public Enterprises in the country by way of expansion, new commissioning or other activities;
- (b) if so, the details of new employment generated by Heavy Industries (large scale industries) and Public Enterprises from 2009-10 to 2016-17 and also in 2017-18 as per the latest available information; and
- (c) the details of investment for expansion, new commissioning of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises for the said period?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (c): Since Industry is a State subject, the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) does not maintain any centralized data regarding generation of new employment and investment made in heavy industries in the country. The role of DHI is confined to the administration of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) under its administrative control. So far as details of employment and investment in CPSEs, in the country, is concerned, the Public Enterprises Survey 2015 – 16, already laid in both the houses of Parliament on 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2017 indicates that the total number of employees in CPSEs is declining every year since 2009 – 10 except during 2011 -12 and the investment in these CPSEs during the last 3 years i.e. 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 was Rs. 992095.67 cr., 1095554.32 cr. and 1171844.25 cr. respectively.
