- (a) the mechanism in place to stop the recurrence of snooping incidents in the past by American agencies;
- (b) the details of precautions taken by the Indian intelligence agencies to stop snooping by outside agencies; and
- (c) the policy initiated on snooping after the snooping incidents by US agencies some years back?

(a) to (c): Government has taken measures to enhance its capacity to protect data and information flows by building better infrastructure and by evolving new cyber and telecom security practices.
