Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all works pertaining to hindi are being done by a nominated Hindi Officers in various Ministries, Corporations and Undertakings under the Government of India in place of a regular Rajbhasha Adhikari due to which expansion of Hindi is not being made;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total number of regular and nominated official language Hindi Officers in the country?

ANSWER

HINDI OFFICERS

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a): The officers/staff of Central Secretariat Official Language Service Cadre are posted in all Ministries/Departments and sub-ordinate offices. Corporations and undertakings and other sub-ordinate offices have their own Rajbhasha/Hindi Officers. However, in a few exceptional cases, in case of non-availability of Hindi/Rajbhasha Officers, the concerned Head of Office may nominate some other officers to do works relating to Rajbhasha. No report has been received in this Department that work relating to Hindi is

being done by nominated Hindi Officer in place of regular Rajbhasha/Hindi Adhikari in various Ministries, Corporations and Undertakings of the Government.

- (c): 705 officers/staff of Central Secretariat Official Language Service Cadre are posted in different Ministries/Departments and sub-ordinate offices.
