(a) and (b): Office of the Registrar General of India (under Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India) has informed that it does not define the minority community in the decennial Population Census conducted by it. It has further informed that Telangana was not a separate State during Census 2011. The State of Telangana was created after Census 2011 comprising of 9 complete districts and part of the district Khammam of the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh.
