STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.3708 BY SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 09.08.2017 REGARDING HOTELS RUN BY RAILWAYS

(a): Presently, four (4) hotels are owned by Indian Railways. These are Rail Yatri Niwas at New Delhi & Howrah and BNR Hotels at Ranchi & Puri. These hotels were handed over to Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd. (IRCTC) on 'as is where is basis' in August 2004 for operation and management. IRCTC is running these railway hotels on Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model. IRCTC charges license fee and fixed user charges from the Sub-Licensee. The details of Licence fee and fixed user charges received in the last three years are as under:

IRCTC, Konkan Railway Corporation Limited (KRCL) and Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation (MTDC) are discussing modalities of setting up a budget hotel at Sawantwadi.
