US VISA TO INDIAN CITIZENS

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Indian nationals who worked in Iraq, Libya and Syria would not be able to get US visa due to the strict visa norms introduced by the US Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken up this issue with the US Government; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) No. There is no ban on Indian nationals working in Iraq, Libya and Syria or in any other country to obtain US visa.
