- (a) Whether CPWD Horticulture Department has got complaints of the pruning of trees of various colonies in Delhi including Minto Road, New Delhi during the last two years;
- (b) if so, the steps taken by the CPWD in this regard;
- (c) whether tree pruning has been pending for a long time for the want of clearance of Forest Department, Government of Delhi; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken by the CPWD to expedite the work to solve the problem of the residents?
