**BUDGET FOR JALORE RAILWAY STATION**

**†3762. SHRI DEVJI M. PATEL:**

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has formulated any scheme to provide drinking water, sheds, display boards, separate toilets for women, hotel and other infrastructural facilities at the Jalore railway station in a time bound manner;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the funds allocated for this purpose;**
- (c) the reasons behind the delay in developing infrastructure at Jalore railway station on the lines of model stations; and**
- (d) the total funds allocated and utilized for passenger amenities at Jalore railway station during the last three years?**

**(a) to (c): Jalore is a 'D' category station dealing with 722 passengers on an average per day. All Minimum Essential Amenities have been provided at this station. This station has already been developed under 'Adarsh Station Scheme. The requisite amenities as specified for Adarsh Station are available at this station. Further, improvement in passenger amenities at a station is a continuous process and is taken up based on the quantum of traffic handled, inter-se priority of works and availability of funds.**

**(d): Station-wise details of funds are not maintained. Works of provision of passenger amenities at railway stations is generally funded under Plan Head-Passenger Amenities. Details of fund allocated and utilized under this Plan Head during the last three years for North Western Railway, which covers Jalore Railway station are as under:**
