Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to ensure the maintenance and availability of water in the public toilets situated in urban areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): As per Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) guidelines, all public toilets constructed under the Mission must have a minimum 5 years maintenance contract and also Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) should ensure that all Public Toilets constructed are built in tandem with water supply arrangements and consist of toilet sub-structure like on-site treatment system, or connection to underground sewerage/septage system to be functional. For monitoring the level of maintenance, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has devised a process of survey through Swachh Survekshan where mode of cities are tested. The mode of maintenance is judged as under:

SI. No.	Gradation of marks for this parameter	Points
i.	Maintenance by third party/private contractor	23
ii.	Maintenance by municipal employees	11
iii.	No maintenance	0
