TICKET SCANNING SYSTEM

3784. MOHAMMED FAIZAL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to implement metro model ticket scanning system at the railway stations;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether the Government has identified any railway stations for the same and if so, the details thereof;**
- (d) the details of funds allocated and sanctioned for this purpose; and**
- (e) the time by which this system is likely to be implemented?**

(a) to (e): Yes, Madam. Indian Railways has decided to introduce “Automatic Gate Based Ticket Checking System” on pilot basis.

A new work for “Automatic Gate Based Ticket Checking System” has been sanctioned in the year 2017-18 at an abstract cost of ₹ 4.16 Crore.

The pilot project is likely to be implemented at Barar Square Square Railway Station in Delhi shortly.
